Prayer of Confession

Prince of Peace and God of all nations, we come to you in need of your mercy. You invite us to a table of perfect unity, yet we confess that we live in a world torn by division, and we are not innocent of its fractures.

You call us to be peacemakers, yet we confess that our own hearts are often filled with anxiety and turmoil. We allow fear to guide our words and actions. We contribute to conflict in our homes and workplaces with sharp tongues and hardened hearts. We see the violence and strife across the world, and we feel helpless, turning away rather than turning to you in faithful prayer and action.

Spirit of Unity, you bind us together as one Body in Christ, yet we confess that we have wounded that Body. We have allowed our disagreements to become divisions. We have mistaken our preferences for your principles. We have judged our brothers and sisters who worship, speak, or look different from us, forgetting that we are all your beloved children, from every tribe, tongue, and nation.

As we approach this table, remind us that the bread is broken so that we might be made whole, and the cup is poured out to wash away our sin. Make us into the people you call us to be: agents of your peace, ministers of your reconciliation, and living signs of your unity to a watching and waiting world.
